Wedding Policies

Member of Palo Duro Cowboy Church will not be charged for the use of the church facilities; however, fees are charged to compensate the people needed to render the requested service. The \$100 deposit must be made at the time the reservation form is completed. Deposit will be deducted from rental fee when paid in full.

Music

All wedding music will be appropriately selected to observe the sacredness and dignity of the wedding service.

Decorations

All decorations belonging to Palo Duro Cowboy Church will not be removed or tampered with in any way. Any decorations brought in for the wedding must be removed immediately after the wedding. All decorations (such as cans) tied or placed on the car must be consistent with the standards set by the church family at PDCC. No beer cans, wine bottles, or other things in poor taste are to be placed on the cars as long as they are in the church parking area.

Ministerial & Music Staff

The pastor is not obligated, by virtue of his position, to participate in wedding ceremonies. It is the responsibility of the wedding party to make an appointment with the pastor and/or the minister of music if their services are desired.

General Rules

Absolutely not alcoholic beverages are permitted in any of the buildings or on the church grounds.

Smoking is not permitted in any of the church buildings, including the restrooms.

Rice is not to be thrown. Birdseed may be thrown outside the buildings.

Liability

Palo Duro Cowboy Church, Canyon, Texas, assumes no responsibility for the security of personal possessions or decorations associated with the wedding.

All liability resulting from a violation of any of the above policies &/or rules, will be the legal responsibility of the bride and groom.
